Saratoga County Public Health Nursing Services will be offering an H1N1 Flu Clinic for **students, parents, siblings 4 years and older, school staff and community members** in the Stillwater Central School District on:

Date: Wednesday, January 13, 2010

Time: 4 pm to 8 pm

Location: Stillwater Elementary School Gymnasium

PLEASE NOTE:

- There is no fee and no appointment is necessary to come to this clinic.
- Only the H1N1 shot will be given at the clinic. Please note that there may be preservative (thimerosal) in the vaccine.
- Parents who want their child to receive the H1N1 nasal mist may check with their Health Care Provider or call Saratoga County Public Health at 584-7460 to schedule an appointment
- Children under 10 years old will need to receive a second dose after 28 days. You may get this from your Health Care Provider, from Public Health or a Clinic for second doses at the school may be scheduled. **Please keep the Patient Copy form that you will be given after the first vaccine and bring it with you for verification for the second dose.**
- We do not anticipate a vaccine shortage for any students coming to the school clinic.
- A parent/guardian will need to be present to sign for the consent to receive the vaccine for any child under 18 years old. If you need to send your child with another adult, a parental permission letter must be sent in that is signed and dated.
