\*If voters do not approve the proposed 2019-20 budget within two votes, the Board must adopt a contingent budget, which limits the property tax levy increase to zero percent, with no exclusions. The tax levy would need to be reduced by \$380,285. Deliberations would center around using fund balance, finding additional revenue, and reducing expenditures. Reductions to be considered would include non-mandated courses, athletics and extra curricular activities. The above represents one possible scenario available to the district.
